At the heart of the Foundation's mission is the **National Museum of the Marine Corps**, a world-class museum that will immerse visitors in the history of our Great Nation...through the eyes of Marines.

Its sweeping design evokes the image of the flag raisers of Iwo Jima and beckons visitors to its 100,000 square foot structure, situated on a 135-acre site adjacent to the Marine Corps base at Quantico, Virginia.

The Museum houses an unparalleled display of icons of Marine history...like the renowned Iwo Jima Flag...an original leather neck stock...an 1804 gilt brass button bearing the famed eagle, globe, and anchor...the officers "Mameluke" sword that was carried by Commandant Archibald Henderson...a genuine M26 "Pershing" tank...and hundreds more irreplaceable artifacts.

The finest museum technology and multimedia effects in our exhibitions create pivotal moments in history, like the landing on Iwo Jima on D-Day in 1945, and the 1968 Khe Sanh siege during the Vietnam War. Visitors experience the intensity of boot camp...or test their rifle skills with an M-16 at the Marine Corps virtual practice range...engulfng themselves in the sights and sounds of Marines in action.
